Step 1: Download the QuickTime 5 Installer

First, make sure that you are connected to the Internet. Then, using your web browser (Netscape, Internet Explorer, etc...), go to Apple Computer's Quicktime web site: <http://www.apple.com/quicktime/download/>. Follow the directions on this page to download the free QuickTime Player.

Step 2: Run the QuickTime 5 Installer

After clicking Download QuickTime on the QuickTime web site, the QuickTime Installer will automatically download and begin the installation process.

After reading the Welcome message and information about QuickTime, click Next.

Step 3: Read the QuickTime 5 License Agreement

After reading the license agreement, you must click Agree in order to continue installing QuickTime software.

Step 4: Select a Destination for QuickTime 5

The Choose Destination Location window will appear.

Select the directory in install the QuickTime software by clicking Browse. When you have selected the directory, click Next.

Step 5: Choose QuickTime 5 Installation Type

After agreeing to the software license, the Choose Installation Type options appear.

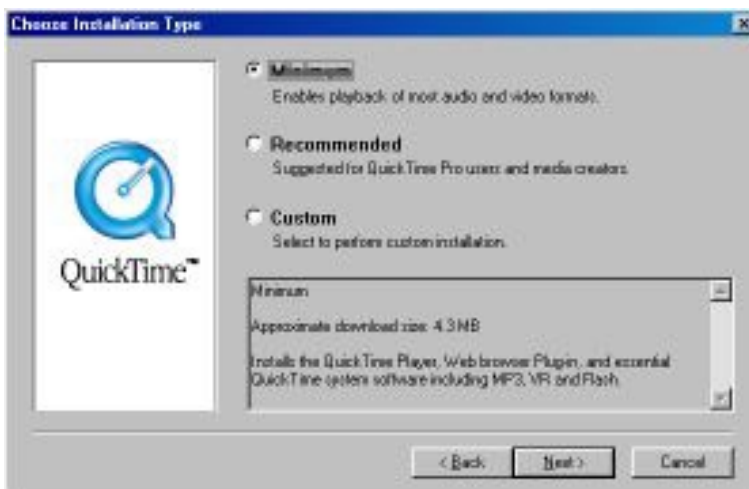


Figure 3 Choose Installation Type window

Pediatrics Streaming Grand Rounds requires the **Recommended** install of QuickTime 5.

After selecting the setup type and installation options, click Next.

Step 6: Name the QuickTime 5 Folder

Next, the Select Program Folder window will appear.

The setup program automatically creates a folder called QuickTime to install program icons. You can type a new folder name or select an existing folder from the list. Once you have made your selections, click Next.

Step 7: Select Browsers for QuickTime 5 Plug-ins

After creating the QuickTime folder, the QuickTime Plug-in Options window appears.

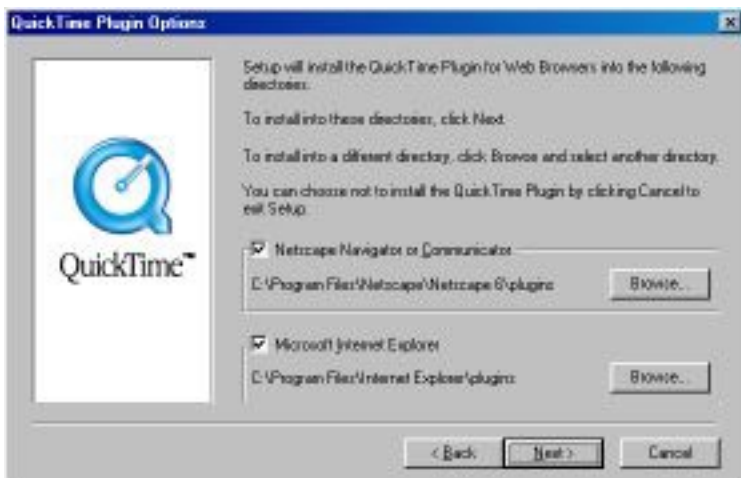


Figure 5 QuickTime Plug-in Options window

The setup program installs the QuickTime plug-in into the Microsoft Internet Explorer or Netscape Navigator or Communicator plug-in folder. To locate additional browser plug-ins folders, click Browse. Once you have made your selections, click Next

Step 8: QuickTime 5 Registration

Next you will see the Enter Registration window.

If you have a QuickTime Pro registration number, enter the registration name and number, then click the Next button. QuickTime 3/4 registration numbers will not work with QuickTime 5.

Click Next without entering any information if you do not have a QuickTime Pro registration number.

Step 9: Initiate the QuickTime 5 Data Download

The next steps will download the necessary software files and complete the installation.

If you need to use a Proxy connection to the Internet, click the check box for “Use HTTP Proxy” and enter the address of the Proxy server. Otherwise, leave the “Use HTTP Proxy” box unchecked and click Continue.

If you are unsure of these settings please contact your network or systems administrator.

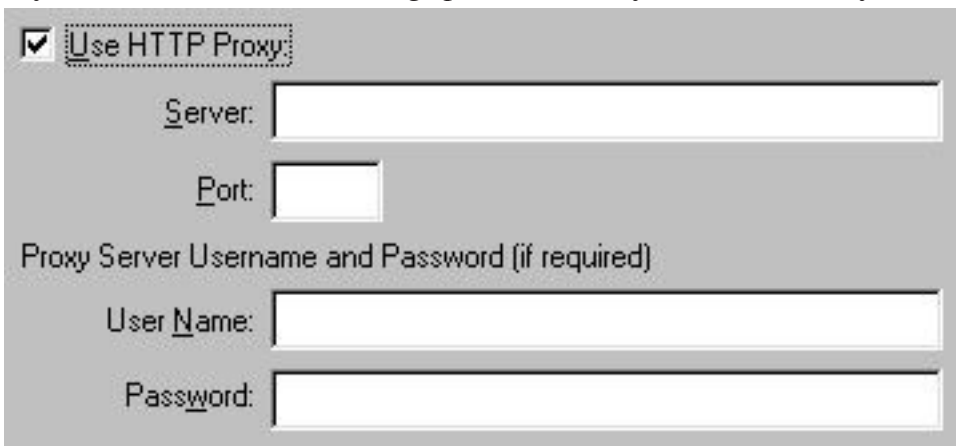


Figure 8 Use HTTP Proxy screen

When you are ready to install the QuickTime software, click Continue.

Step 10: QuickTime 5 Installation

The QuickTime Installer will connect to the Internet and begin downloading the files needed to complete the installation.

Once you click the Continue button, the download time estimates will vary depending on the type of installation you have selected and the speed of your Internet connection; it may take as long as 105 minutes to download all files.

Tip: If you cancel the file download or lose connection during the download process, all files that were able to be downloaded will be automatically saved. When you begin the installation again, the remaining files will be downloaded.

The QuickTime Installer begins installing the QuickTime software files.

Next, the QuickTime Setup Assistant appears.

Step 11: QuickTime 5 Setup Assistant

Follow the on-screen instructions to set the connection speed, QuickTime browser plug-in settings, and file type associations.

Upon successful installation, the completion message appears.

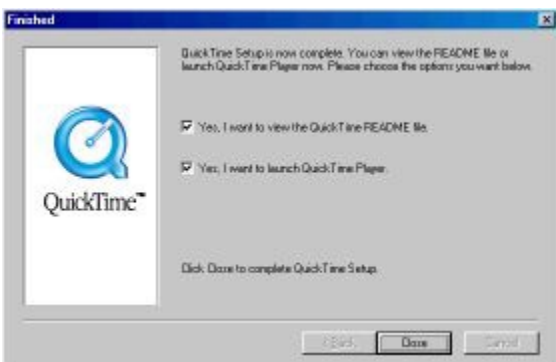


Figure 12 QuickTime Installer Finished screen

When you have completed your selections, click Close.

Note: Open the QuickTime Player and play the sample movie to verify the installation.
